The drugs will be turned over to the Drug Enforcement Agency to be incinerated. Locally, the Drug Take-Back Day is sponsored by MADCAT and the McMinn County Sheriff's Office.

NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

◆ Three American doctors were killed when an Afghan security guard opened fire at a Kabul hospital. One of the doctors has been identified as Dr. Jerry Umanos, a pediatrician from Chicago. An American nurse was wounded in the attack.

◆ The federal government is proposing to ban the sale of electronic cigarettes to minors and to require health warning labels. The Food and Drug Administration says the proposed rules are aimed at regulating the popular e-cigarettes, but the rules do not ban them or curb marketing on places like TV.

◆ School officials have removed a Bible verse from a high school gymnasium in Parkersburg, West Virginia, after a complaint from the Wisconsin-based Freedom from Religion Foundation. The group complained because the verse, "I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me," from Philippians 4:13 was painted above the doors to the wrestling room in the gym and appeared on the wrestling team's T-shirts.

◆ Australian authorities say a piece of sheet metal with rivets that washed ashore did not come from the missing Malaysia Airlines jet.
