### NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

- ◆ A young homeless woman accused of abandoning her 11 month old baby on a crowded subway platform in the heart of Manhattan was charged in a New York court on Tuesday. The little girl was left in a stroller at the Columbus Circle station, on Monday.
- ◆ More than 80 passengers were injured when two trains collided in the South African city of Durban on Tuesday evening. Neither of the trains derailed and none of the passengers were trapped in the accident.
- ◆ Iraq's government has lost control of a former chemical weapons facility to "armed terrorist groups" and is unable to fulfill its international obligations to destroy toxins kept there. The Muthanna facility north of Baghdad was seized on June 11, where remnants of a former chemical weapons program are kept in two bunkers there.
- ◆ Two people died on Tuesday in a shooting at a medical center in Spokane, Washington. It appears that a man shot a woman before taking his own life. The Spokane Police Department believes it is a case of domestic violence.
- ◆ Germany inflicted an historic 7-1 rout of Brazil on Tuesday to reach the World Cup final. Miroslav Klose became the all-time leading scorer in the history of the tournament. Germany plays the winner of the Netherlands vs. Argentina match which will be played today at 4 p.m. and will be broadcast on ESPN.
