LOCAL & AREA NEWS

◆ LIGHTNING PUNCTURES GAS LINE

Athens Utilities Board crews responded to a house on Housley Drive after Wednesday night's thunderstorms. The homeowner reported a strong odor of natural gas and a hissing sound in the yard. It turns out that lightning had struck a tree and traveled to the ground, hitting the gas line. AUB crews capped gas service off and repaired the gas line. Lightning also struck distribution lines and caused a high voltage line to burn down near Middle Creek nursery, knocking off electricity to 517 customers. The power was off for about an hour and a half. AUB says there were also outages affecting 69 customers in the City Park area.

NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

◆ A California chemical engineer, Walter Liew, was sentenced to 15 years in prison and fined \$28 million by a federal judge in Oakland. He was convicted for a rare case of economic-espionage. Liew sold to China the technology that creates a white pigment known as titanium dioxide. A U.S. District Court Judge said that Liew had turned against his adopted country because of greed.

◆ A man charged with killing four children and their parents forced his way into the family's suburban Houston home, tied them up and shot them in the back of the head when they refused to tell him where his ex-wife was.

◆ A 15-year-old was charged Thursday with one count of criminal homicide in the fatal shooting of a longtime member of the Tennessee National Guard at a Lobelville, Tennessee armory.
