◆ MOTORCYCLE GANGS HAVE SHOOTOUT

A fight between members of rival motorcycle gangs at Applebee's Restaurant in Athens Friday night, led to the arrest of 5 men on charges of attempted first degree murder by Athens Police. Members of the Widomakers/Outlaw gang got into a fight with members of the Heathens/Nomad gang at Applebees. Members of the Widomakers/Outlaws traveled across Decatur Pike to the Kangaroo Gas Station and were apparently followed there by members of the Heathens/Nomad gang who started firing weapons. They were met with return fire. Two men, Patrick Petty and Steven Kirkland, ages and addresses unknown, were shot and flown to the U.T. Medical Center in Knoxville. The Widomakers established a "clubhouse" in Athens about a year ago. It's located on Railroad Avenue at Congress Parkway, across from "Hair Therapy."

◆ UNEMPLOYMENT RISES IN AREA

The unemployment rate has risen in each of the past three months in McMinn County. The jobless rate in June was 8.2%, up from 7% in May and up from 6.5% in April. In Meigs County, unemployment in June was 9%, up from 7.7% in May. Monroe County's jobless rate in June was 8.9%, up from 7.7% in May.

WORLD & NATIONAL NEWS

◆ The Islamist Hamas movement has continued firing rockets at Israel, despite claims it had accepted a UN request for a 24-hour extension of a humanitarian truce in war-torn Gaza.

◆ Nigerian health authorities are trying to stop the spread of Ebola after a Liberian man sick with one of the world's deadliest diseases brought it by plane to Lagos, Africa's largest city with 21 million people. The man died on Friday. Health officials have raised new fears that other passengers could take the disease beyond Africa due to weak inspection of passengers and the fact Ebola's symptoms are similar to other diseases.

◆ Ukrainian armed forces have mounted a major onslaught against pro-Russian separatist fighters in an attempt to gain control over the area where a Malaysia Airlines plane was downed earlier this month.

◆ The U.S. has released satellite images that it says back up its claims that rockets have been fired from Russia into eastern Ukraine and heavy artillery for separatists has also crossed the border.

◆ The U.S. has evacuated its embassy in Libya, driving diplomats across the border into Tunisia under heavy military escort after escalating clashes broke out between rival militias in Tripoli. The violence is the worst seen since the 2011 fall of Muammar Gaddafi.
