### ◆ AUB TO CHECK FOR GAS LEAKS

Natural gas crews and contractors for Athens Utilities Board this week will begin a leak survey of AUB's natural gas distribution system in Athens and McMinn County. Federal regulations require that natural gas distribution systems be checked each five years. During the work over the next several months, you may see AUB employees and contractors in trucks bearing the Lisco, Inc., insignia on your property. The crews will move from property to property with leak-detection equipment checking main gas lines in the streets and rights of way as well as customer service lines all the way to the customer meters at homes and businesses.

## NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

- ◆ Iraq's Prime Minister has called upon his country's armed forces to help the Kurdish military battle a Sunni militant offensive in northern Iraq that has caused tens of thousands of people to flee their homes.
- ◆ A man was admitted to a New York City hospital Monday with symptoms similar to those of Ebola and was being tested though odds are he is not infected, according to officials. The patient recently traveled to a West African country where Ebola has been reported.
- ◆ The World Bank has announced up to \$200 million in emergency assistance to help Liberia, Sierra Leone and Guinea contain the spread of the deadly Ebola virus. The funding will also help the countries improve their public health systems and cope with the economic impact of the crisis.
- ◆ James Brady, Ronald Reagan's press secretary, has died at age 73. Brady received a gunshot to the head during the assassination attempt on President Reagan in 1981, which left him disabled.

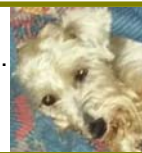
