Local & State News

◆ **TOMORROW IS ELECTION DAY**
 Thursday is election day. It's the County General and the State Primary. Here in McMinn County, the polls will be open from 9 a.m. to 8 p.m. The Athens City Schools will be closed tomorrow, since most schools are used as voting locations. The McMinn County Schools are also closed. Students had an abbreviated day of classes yesterday, and do not return to school until August 12th.

◆ **COMMUNITY NEWS YOU CAN USE:**

- ✓ Athens Utilities Board advises that there will be a brief power outage for their customers served by the Englewood substation at midnight tonight. Spokesman Wayne Scarbrough says AUB is refurbishing the high-voltage transformers inside the substation. Tonight's outage is necessary so AUB can transfer the entire load of the Englewood substation over to a mobile substation, which will be used for about a month while work on the main substation transformers takes place.
- ✓ The Arts Center of Athens will present **Open Mic Night** this Friday, Aug. 8th, at 7:30 p.m. at the Sue E. Trotter Black Box Theater. Admission is free. The event is part of the House Blend Concert Series.

NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

- ◆ American Army Major General Harold J. Greene, a 34-year veteran, was shot to death Tuesday in one of the bloodiest insider attacks of the long Afghanistan war. A gunman dressed as an Afghan soldier turned on allied troops, wounding about 15 including a German general and two Afghan generals.
- ◆ Russian hackers have stolen 1.2 billion Internet credentials from major US companies and others around the world in what is likely the biggest data breach ever. The hackers stole confidential user names and passwords from some 420,000 websites, ranging from household names to small Internet sites.
- ◆ A retired doctor from Morristown, TN, who helped treat Ebola patients in Liberia remains quarantined at his home. Dr. Alan Jamison traveled to Liberia on July 7th with Medical Teams International. He was at the same hospital as Dr. Kent Brantly, who contracted Ebola there and is being treated at Emory University Hospital. Dr. Jamison says he has no symptoms, but has voluntarily confined himself out of caution. People exposed to Ebola can go without symptoms for up to 21 days. Dr. Jamison will remain quarantined until Saturday, which marks 21 days since he last had contact with an Ebola patient.
