◆ The mother of Steven Sotloff, the American freelance journalist held hostage by Islamic militants, stated that her son wanted to tell the world, through his writing, about oppressed people in the Middle East. Shirley Sotloff is appealing to her son's captors to have mercy on a man sympathetic to the suffering of Muslims.

◆ A retired New York City Police detective, Bill Burns, has organized "Operation Blue Monday." He's urging everyone to wear something blue next Monday, Sept. 1st, to honor America's law enforcement officers.
