State & Local News

◆ NEW McMINN COUNTY MAPS AVAILABLE

Brand new maps of McMinn County are now available. Choate Printing, in partnership with the Etowah Chamber of Commerce, has printed a detailed map that includes all county roads, streets, and highways as well as Athens, Etowah, Englewood, Niota and Riceville city streets. The maps are free and can be picked up at the Etowah Area Chamber of Commerce, Choate Printing at 707 Ohio Avenue in Etowah, or at most area attractions, hotels, and visitor centers.

- ✓ The Meigs County Commission will hold a special called meeting tonight at 7 at the Courthouse.
- ✓ The Tennessee College of Applied Technology in Athens will hold an open house for its Pharmacy Technology Program Thursday from 5 to 7 p.m. and Friday from 10 a.m. to 12 noon. There will be food and information about the program.
- ✓ A "Strides for Help 5K" will be held this Saturday to benefit the McMinn/Meigs County Cancer Relief Fund. The run starts at Applebee's with registration at 7:30 a.m. The cost is \$25. Each participant will receive a t-shirt and a goody bag. There will be awards for winners in each age group.

National & International News

◆ President Obama, who is in Estonia to meet over a NATO initiative amid the Ukrainian crisis, confirmed the authenticity of the video showing the execution of journalist Steven Sotloff by ISIL. An Israeli spokesman revealed that Sotloff held dual American-Israeli citizenship. Sotloff had kept his Judaism a secret from the Islamist extremists, pretending he was sick when he fasted for the Yom Kippur holiday.

◆ Two women are the first recipients of an experimental Ebola vaccine which had previously been tested only in monkeys. The trial will test the safety of the vaccine, which was developed by GlaxoSmithKline and the NIH's National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Diseases. More than 1,900 people have died from the Ebola infection in West Africa, according to the World Health Organization.

◆ The Woodland Hills Youth Development Center in Nashville, where more than 30 teens escaped under a fence, has a long history of violence, allegations of sexual abuse and previous efforts to break out. The center holds 78 teenagers who have committed at least three felonies. Most of the teens' crimes relate to property damage, assault and robbery.
