◆ VEHICLE WRECKS & FLIPS IN ETOWAH

WORLD & NATIONAL NEWS

◆ Nissan has announced it is recalling more than 52,000 vehicles for passenger air bags that can explode with too much force and send shards of metal into the passenger compartment. The Nissan recalls are among nearly 8 million others by 10 automakers, due to faulty air bags made by the Japanese supplier, Takata Corp.

◆ President Obama's pick to be the next attorney general faces a difficult confirmation process. Obama named New York federal prosecutor Loretta Lynch to the job. Republicans want to hold off on a confirmation vote until they take control of the Senate in January.

◆ An employee of a bowling alley near Cincinnati, Ohio, was crushed to death in a freak accident when he got entangled in a pin-setting machine.

◆ In England, a medical examiner has determined the cause of death of a man who collapsed at the estate where he worked and died five days later of multiple organ failure. He says the 33-year-old man was poisoned when he accidentally brushed against a deadly flower known as Devil's helmet.

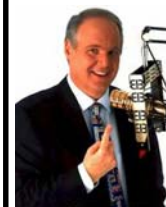
