### LOCAL & AREA NEWS

◆ **MEIGS COUNTY RECORDS FATALITY**

A man from Madisonville, identified as Jeffrey E. Hardee, age 34, was killed in a two-vehicle crash around 10:22 a.m. Saturday. According to the THP report, Hardee was driving a 2001 Hyundai northbound on Highway 68, when he crossed the center line and struck a 2014 GMC Yukon head-on. Hardee was the only passenger in his vehicle and was reported dead at the scene. Hardee was not wearing any safety restraints and drugs were suspected of contributing to the wreck. There were five passengers in the Yukon; 3 adults, a boy age 2, and a girl 5 months old. All of them were injured and were from Lloydminster, Saskatchewan, Canada.

◆ **RAINBOW "SPA" ORDERED CLOSED BY JUDGE**

The TBI along with the Athens Police Department and the McMinn Sheriff's Department served search warrants last Wednesday at the Rainbow "Spa", 2915 Decatur Pike, Athens, after suspecting that the "spa" was engaging in prostitution and performing massages without a license. Two individuals were questioned and charges are anticipated. ### WORLD & NATIONAL NEWS

◆ ISIS claims to have beheaded American hostage Peter Kassig in new video posted online. Kassig, the fifth Western hostage ISIS has claimed to have killed, changed his name to Abdul Rahman after converting to Islam, according to his parents. The aid worker and former Army Ranger was abducted in October 2013 while traveling to a town in eastern Syria.

◆ Nearly 200 people on a Princess Cruise ship have fallen ill with norovirus. According to Princess Cruises, the Crown Princess, scheduled to sail from Tahiti to Los Angeles, was delayed by a day after a crew member suffered a "serious medical condition."

◆ Bill Cosby has released a statement through a lawyer on his website, declining to comment on the "decade-old, discredited" rape allegations against him.

**FOOTBALL SCORES:** The McMinn Central Chargers defeated Red Bank in the second round of the TSSAA High School (3A) football playoffs. The score was 30 to 7. Central will play Notre Dame in the third round this week. Notre Dame defeated Upperman 55 to 7. Tennessee defeated Kentucky in Knoxville on Saturday by a score of 50 to 16. U.T. has beaten Kentucky at home for the 15th consecutive time, winning 29 of the last 30 meetings. The last time U.T. (5-5; 2-4 SEC) scored 50 points in SEC action, was on November 13th, 2010, defeating Ole Miss 52-14.
