What To Do If Police Stop You

The Athens Police Department has received several complaints of vehicles attempting to pull over citizens without having any type of marking other than a flashing white or blue light. Chief Chuck Ziegler has the following advice in the event you are pulled over:

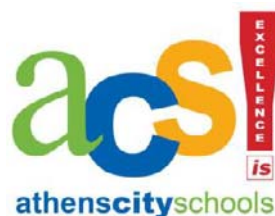
1. If you see blue lights behind you, the officer is requesting the right to road clearance or the officer is signaling you to pull over.
2. If the patrol car is a marked unit, pull over as far to the right as safely possible. The City of Athens only uses marked patrol cars for stopping cars. It will be a white patrol car with a blue stripe on the side and will have blue lights.
3. Several police agencies in the area do use unmarked cars to perform traffic stops. If the car that is pulling you over is unmarked and you do not feel safe stopping, turn on your safety flashers and pull over at the nearest lighted area. Call 911 and report the stop. The dispatcher will tell you if this is a genuine police stop. You should stay in your vehicle unless directed by the officer to get out.
4. The officer will ask you for some information, your driver's license, proof of insurance, and the vehicle registration. You will be told why you were stopped. If you receive a citation, the officer will advise you of your court date, which allows you to appear before a judge. Athens officers will give you a traffic fact sheet explaining how you can dispose of your case with a minimum of trouble and expense. After the traffic stop is completed, you should use caution and return to the flow of traffic.
