◆ A "DRIVE-IN" AT THE DOLLAR STORE

A 57-year-old woman has been charged with reckless driving after crashing her car into the Dollar General Store in Englewood. The woman told police she mistakenly hit the gas pedal instead of the brakes, and her car plowed through the front doors of the store on Highway 411. The car barely missed hitting a cashier and a child. The doors fell on a man, but he walked away with only a few scratches on his arm.

◆ Francisco Sanchez, an illegal immigrant, allegedly gunned down a young woman, Kate Steinle, last week as she walked with her father on Pier 14 in a tourist-heavy area of San Francisco. This was apparently a random killing. Sanchez has already been deported five times to his native Mexico and has now been formally charged with murder.

◆ Four television news crews were setting-up for live shots near where the 32-year-old woman was shot and killed the evening before in a random shooting by an illegal immigrant (in the above story). As they adjusted their cameras, an armed gunman rushed up, ordered the crew to the ground, pistol-whipped one photographer, and ran off with two cameras and one tripod.

◆ Two people died Tuesday when an F-16 military jet fighter crashed into a small single-engine Cessna airplane in midair about 11 miles north of Charleston, South Carolina.
