◆ MEIGS CO. MAN CHARGED WITH MURDER

A Meigs County man, 57-year-old Gary Wayne Ford, has been charged with Second Degree Murder in the death of a Sweetwater woman, 51-year-old Coleen Francis Turner. Turner's body was found on April 10th at a home on Lefew Road in Ten Mile. The TBI developed information leading to the arrest and indictment of Ford. Ford was booked into the Meigs County Jail and is being held on \$100,000 bond.



◆ FATAL WRECK ON I-75 NORTHBOUND

A single vehicle wreck Wednesday afternoon shortly after 1 p.m. claimed the life of one person. The wreck happened just south of the main Athens exit at Mile Marker 48.5, on the northbound side. The vehicle exited the road and came to rest in the median and then burst into flames, catching the grass on fire and killing the driver. The THP will release the full details after the next of kin have been notified.

NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

◆ For a few very frequent fliers, an upgrade on Delta for the very best customers could be an option to fly private instead. Delta calls this option "a new surprise-and-delight program" limited to Medallion members traveling on select commercial Delta flights. The new program is patent-pending, and Delta is the only U.S. airline that owns a private jet company.

◆ Stocks rose higher on an indication from the Federal Reserve that it may raise interest rates later this year. The Dow closed up 120 points while the NASDAQ rose 23 points, and the S&P added 15 points.

MORE STATE NEWS

◆ First it was General Nathan Bedford Forrest. Now, it's President Andrew Jackson. The chairwoman of the Tennessee Democratic Party, Mary Mancini, wants to begin a discussion about whether the party's annual fundraiser should continue to be named after Jackson because of his participation in slavery and the forced removal of Native Americans to Oklahoma on the Trail of Tears.

◆ State Representative Rick Womick has written a letter to all 95 county clerks in Tennessee urging them to ignore the recent Supreme Court ruling redefining marriage, and to refuse to issue marriage licenses to same-sex couples.

- 1863** - Automaker Henry Ford was born near Dearborn, Michigan. He started the Ford Motor Company and unveiled his masterpiece, the Model T, in 1908. He also introduced the conveyer-belt assembly line method of making cars which revolutionized manufacturing.
- 1898** - Kellogg invented corn flakes.
- 1909** - The first airplane was delivered to the U.S. War Department.
- 1926** - Christine McGuire, one of the singing McGuire Sisters, was born.
- 1941** - Singer Paul Anka was born. His first hit record was "Diana."
- 1942** - The WAVES (Women Accepted for Volunteer Emergency Services) was formed.
- 1956** - "In God We Trust" officially became the U.S. motto.
- 1965** - Medicare, the government-funded health insurance program for the elderly, was created.
