### NATIONAL AND WORLD NEWS

- ◆ Russian warplanes bombing targets in Syria have violated Turkish airspace more than once. NATO officials claim a second incursion across the Syrian-Turkish border occurred over the weekend. Moscow says that its aircraft entered Turkish airspace by accident.
- ◆ While rain has stopped falling in South Carolina, the deadly storm continues to bring devastation as numerous dams have been breached, bridges collapsed and hundreds of roads were inundated with floodwaters, causing emergency evacuations.
- ◆ On Tuesday, the Dow Jones Average was up 13.76 at 16,790.19. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was down 7.13 at 1,979.92, and the NASDAQ Composite Index was down 32.90 at 4,748.36.
