1784 - Composer Thomas Hastings was born. He composed the music to the hymn, "Rock of Ages."
1917 - Gertrude Zelle, the most notorious spy of World War One, was executed by a firing squad. She was known by the name, Mata Hari.
1928 - The German dirigible Graf Zeppelin arrived in the United States on its first commercial flight after a four-and-a-half-day trip across the Atlantic.
