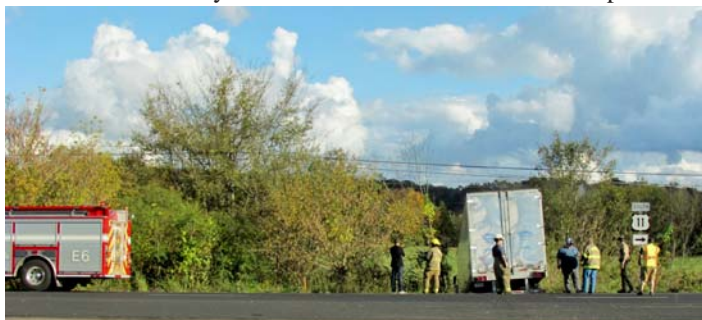
State and Local News

◆ FUGITIVE CAUGHT IN OHIO, CHILD SAFE

A Knoxville man was captured in Ohio on Thursday, just hours after being added to the TBI's Most Wanted list. Tyler Ward Enix, 36, who is the father of the subject of an AMBER Alert issued Wednesday, was captured in a rural area of Morrow County, Ohio, after a citizen heard the Alert on their car radio, realized he was behind the vehicle, and called 911. Enix was taken into custody without incident. His 2-year-old daughter, Brooklynnne, was recovered unharmed. Enix was wanted by the Knoxville Police Department for 1st Degree murder in the death of his wife, Kimberly, who was found murdered in her apartment. The AMBER Alert was issued because their daughter, Brookelynnne, was missing.

◆ TRUCK RUNS OFF U.S.11 IN RICEVILLE

NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

◆ The tail section and detached tether portion of an Army based blimp that caused an aerial "manhunt" on Wednesday have now been removed from the crash site. The blimp was a part of a test program launched by the Pentagon intended to detect drones and cruise missiles.

◆ A Dynamic Airways jet, a Boeing 767, caught fire while taxiing for departure at Fort Lauderdale International Airport in Florida on Thursday. The plane was bound for Caracas, Venezuela and was leaking fuel before the fire started.

◆ Scott Kelly, U.S. astronaut, spent his 216th consecutive day in space on Thursday. Kelly surpassed the previous record held by U.S. astronaut Michael Lopez-Alegria who spent 215 days in space as commander of the Expedition 14 crew in 2006.

◆ China announced at a Communist Party leadership meeting that it is ending its one child only policy. This ends the controversial 36-year-old policy.

◆ Rep. Paul Ryan of Wisconsin was officially elected as the 54th speaker of the House after he got the votes of 236 members by the full House of Representatives.
