### ◆ ATHENS MAN DIES WHEN WRECKER FALLS

A 44-year-old Athens man, Casey Lewis Barstow, has died from injuries caused when a wrecker he was working on fell on him. Reports say Barstow was working on a wrecker at Womac Wrecker Service last week when the accident occurred. He was taken to Erlanger Hospital, where he died from the injuries.

### ◆ E.G. FISHER SEEKS TWO NEW LIBRARIANS

### NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

- ◆ Senator Bernie Sanders won Wyoming's Democratic caucus on Saturday, his 8th win in the past nine contests.
- ◆ Police in Gatlinburg discovered a man and woman dead in a hot tub of a cabin. No cause of the deaths has been released, but police do not suspect foul play. They were in their early 60's.
- ◆ For the first time in nearly a century, the cost of mailing a letter has fallen. The rate dropped from 49 cents to 47 cents on Sunday. If you stocked up on Forever stamps, you may want to wait until the price goes back up before using them.

### NCAA PENALIZES TYNDALL

The NCAA has slapped former UT basketball coach Donnie Tyndall with a 10-year show-cause penalty, meaning he will likely be out of NCAA coaching for a decade. The NCAA says Tyndall directed his staff at Southern Mississippi to complete fraudulent course work for prospects so they could be eligible to play, gave impermissible financial aid to students, and refused to cooperate in the NCAA investigation. He later became head basketball coach at UT before being fired in March 2015 after one season. He moved to Athens last fall and worked for a brief period in a volunteer role as associate athletic director at Tennessee Wesleyan.
