NATIONAL & LOCAL NEWS

- ◆ A pilot is dead after an aerobatic plane crashed at an airshow in DeKalb County, Georgia. A crowd of spectators were watching the airplane attempt an aerobatic manuver at DeKalb-Peachtree Airport when it plummeted into the ground.
- ◆ The gun George Zimmerman used to kill 17-year-old Trayvon Martin has been re-listed for auction after the original listing appeared to be hijacked by fake accounts posting astronomically high bids. Zimmerman said that the new listing with the United Gun Group is legitimate. The starting bid is \$100,000 with a \$500,000 "buy it now" price.
- ◆ President Obama issued a statement on Friday through the Department of Education, that explains the federal government's stance when it comes to restrooms, locker rooms, athletics or same-sex classes. The DOE said that public schools, colleges, universities and educational institutions receiving federal funding must allow transgender students to have access to facilities consistent with their gender identity or those institutions will risk losing their federal funding under Title IX, which prohibits discrimination in education on the basis of sex.
- ◆ A Carnival Cruise Line passenger aboard the Carnival Liberty cruise ship went missing Friday, about 195 miles off the coast of Galveston, Texas. Video shows the passenger, identified as Samantha Broberg, 33, falling overboard, according to Carnival.
- ◆ The socialist president of Venezuela, Nicolas Maduro, may soon be forced from office. The oil-rich country has food and medicine shortages, frequent power interuptions, and massive inflation.
