◆ CHILD DIES WHEN TV FALLS ON HIM

A five-year-old child was killed in a tragic accident Wednesday afternoon at the Kiddie Korner Daycare on Ohio Street in Athens. According to the police incident report, a worker at the daycare facility said the child, Tucker Crane, climbed onto a TV stand which had a large television strapped on top of it. Before she could get him off, the stand and the television fell on top of the boy and his face. He was taken to Starr Regional Medical Center's emergency room, where he was pronounced dead. The TBI, the District Attorney, and the Department of Children's Services are assisting the Athens Police Department in the investigation.

◆ ATHENS CITY MANAGER TO RETIRE

Athens City Manager Mitch Moore has announced that he will retire at the end of the year. Moore has served as the city manager for more than 17 years. In his retirement letter, Moore said it has been his distinct honor and pleasure to serve the citizens of Athens. He said he wanted to leave at a time when the city is in excellent financial condition and is enjoying economic growth. He says he and his wife, Sandy, will continue to live in Athens and stay active in the community. Police Chief Chuck Ziegler and Human Resources Director Rita Brown are also retiring this year.

◆ The shooter who killed a UCLA professor Wednesday before turning the gun on himself is the suspect in another homicide in Minnesota, near St. Paul, where he lived. The gunman was identified as a former UCLA student who graduated with a PhD from the school in 2013. He was heavily armed.

◆ A man was rescued in the Gulf of Mexico Thursday after treading water for 20 hours with no life jacket.

◆ Three Fort Hood soldiers have died after a truck overturned in a creek near the military post in Killeen, Texas.

◆ A pilot with the elite Navy Blue Angels flight team died Thursday after his F/A-18 crashed near Smyrna, Tennessee. The crash occurred as the Blue Angels were practicing before this weekend's Great Tennessee Air Show at Smyrna.

◆ In college baseball, the Tennessee Wesleyan Bulldogs are headed home from the Avista-NAIA Baseball World Series after losing to Faulkner, 4 to 3, Wednesday night, in Lewiston, Idaho.
