♦ RICEVILLE MAN DIES IN HEAD-ON CRASH

Ryne Thornburg, 25, of Riceville, was killed in a head-on collision on U.S. 11 near Calhoun last Friday afternoon. The state patrol says Thornburg was traveling south when he was struck by a Jeep Cherokee that was going north. Troopers say the Cherokee was driven by 45-year-old Sherry Mason. She told first responders she had dropped a cigarette, and while she was reaching for it, she swerved into the southbound lanes. Thornburg died at the scene. Mason was airlifted to Erlanger. Troopers say drugs may have been a factor in the crash.

◆ MASSIVE POWER OUTAGE HITS ATHENS

Power to 12,300 Athens Utilities Board customers was off for nearly an hour Saturday morning after a fire at the Athens substation on Ingleside Avenue. AUB's Wayne Scarbrough says a TVA capacitor bank caught fire, causing a TVA breaker to fail. That killed the power to AUB's North Athens, Central Athens, South Athens, and Englewood substations. ♦ APRIL JOBLESS RATE DIPS IN AREA

The unemployment rate in most counties in Southeast Tennessee went down in April. In McMinn County, the jobless rate in April was 4.5%, down from 4.7% in March, Unemployment in Meigs County was up a tick, going from 5.9% in March to 6% in April. In Monroe County, the jobless rate in April was 4.3%, down from 4.6% in March.

◆ A Memphis police officer was killed Saturday night following a downtown shooting that left three people injured. Officer Verdell Smith was struck and killed by the suspect's vehicle as he fled the scene. The suspect is now in custody.

◆ Funeral services for boxing champ Muhammad Ali will be held this Friday in his hometown of Louisville, Kentucky. Former President Bill Clinton, comedian Billy Crystal, and sportscaster Bryant Gumbel will deliver the eulogies. Ali died last Friday night at the age of 74 after a battle with a respiratory illness.
