## NATIONAL-WORLD NEWS

◆ A Chinese fighter jet came within 100 feet of a U.S. Air Force RC-135 reconnaissance plane flying over the East China Sea Tuesday. The crew of the American plane characterized the maneuver as unsafe. It was the second such encounter between American and Chinese aircraft in the last three weeks..

◆ At least 11 people are dead and dozens injured following a car bomb attack in Istanbul Tuesday morning. The attack targeted a police vehicle and occurred near Istanbul University. Seven police officers were among those killed.

◆ Hillary Clinton will likely become the first female Democratic nominee, but she isn't the only woman vying for the job. Dr. Jill Stein is the Green Party candidate for president, and this year marks the second time she's bidding for a chance to turn "the White House into a Green House." Stein is a mother of two grown sons and worked as a doctor in Boston near a number of universities.
