◆ Nine people, including six children, have been killed in a house fire in Memphis, the deadliest house fire in the city since the 1920's. Firefighters broke down security doors to get inside. One victim remains hospitalized.

### LAWSUIT AGAINST DAN EVANS IS DISMISSED

The case of Randy Moss versus McMinn County Highway Commissioner Dan Evans has been dismissed at the request of Moss. Moss filed the suit in August of 2014 after losing the election to Evans. The suit claimed that Evans lacked the qualifications to serve as Highway Commissioner. A chancellor dismissed the case, but Moss appealed. The Appeals Court sent it back to the lower court for trial. However, at the request of Moss, the lawsuit has now been dismissed.

## Fun at Market Park

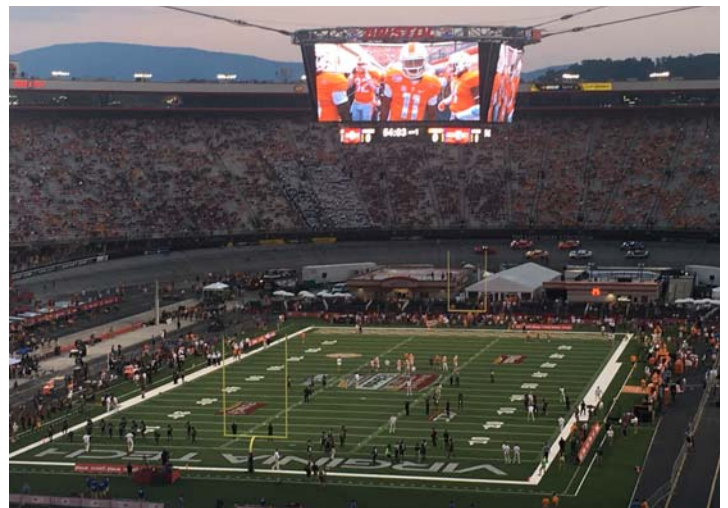

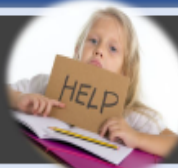
