◆ QUICK ACTION SAVES INMATE'S LIFE

McMinn County Sheriff Joe Guy says quick action by personnel at the Justice Center saved the life of a female inmate who had apparently swallowed narcotics before she was arrested. At the jail, she went unconscious and stopped breathing. Sheriff Guy says Corporal Derrick Saxe, Officers Tammy McMillen and Mary Hollifield, and nurse Benny Richeson responded immediately with a defibrillator and CPR. The inmate was taken by ambulance to Starr Regional Medical Center.

◆ IS BULLYING HAPPENING AT SCHOOL?

The Tennessee Department of Education has released a report on bullying in each school system in the state. The latest data is for the 2013-2014 school year. It shows there were 10,160 cases of bullying reported state-wide. In the McMinn County School System, there were 12 reports of bullying. Athens City Schools had 10 reports of bullying. There were three reports of bullying in the Meigs County schools and 46 cases of bullying reported in the Monroe County schools.

◆ NEW--A MENTAL HEALTH COURT

A new mental health court is coming to McMinn County. The 10th Judicial District Mental Health Court will allow qualified residents of McMinn, Monroe, Polk, and Bradley counties to seek treatment instead of serving jail time for non-violent offenses. The idea for the mental health court comes from Circuit Court Judge Andrew Frieberg.

NATIONAL-WORLD NEWS

◆ The United States government is set to deliver the largest military assistance package in U.S. history to Israel. The State Department said it will host a signing ceremony on Wednesday to mark a memorandum of understanding between the two countries. Details of the deal have not been provided.

◆ Former National Security Agency contractor and American fugitive Edward Snowden said he deserves to be pardoned before President Obama leaves office, suggesting that his actions, while maybe against the letter of the law, changed the country for the better. This is an argument that has so far fallen on deaf ears at the White House.

◆ The New York State attorney general's office has opened a broad inquiry into the Trump Foundation.
