#### ◆ PEDESTRIAN KILLED ON GREEN STREET

A pedestrian was struck and killed on Green Street near Downtown Athens last Friday night. Police say Les Schnepp was crossing Green Street, a short distance from CVS, when he was sideswiped by a pickup truck. The impact knocked him to the pavement, causing severe head trauma. He was airlifted to UT Medical Center, where he died a few hours later. Schnepp was in his mid-50's. He was originally from Illinois, but had lived in Athens for several years.

#### ► FIRE DESTROYS "THE MEAT HOUSE"

The Meat House, a deer processing business located on County Road 364 near Niota, was destroyed by fire last Friday night. When firefighters arrived on the scene, they were met with a building fully involved in flames and several explosions from propane tanks in and around the business. The building and contents were a total loss. The Niota, Athens, and Englewood Rural Fire Departments responded. Niota Rural Fire Chief Lee Mason was in charge.

## National-World News

◆ At least four people are dead in Amarillo, Texas after a home owner sprayed "Weevil-Cide," a pest control chemical that created lethal gas in a home. Another family member allegedly tried to wash it away with water, and it caused a chemical reaction that created phosphine gas, a toxic gas that can cause pulmonary edema and respiratory failure.

◆ Nineteen states raised the minimum wage Sunday that proposes to lift the income of millions of workers. The minimum wage was increased in Alaska, Arizona, Arkansas, California, Colorado, Connecticut, Florida, Hawaii, Maine, Massachusetts, Michigan, Missouri, Montana, New Jersey, New York, Ohio, South Dakota, Vermont, and Washington beginning January 1st.

#### **◆ SUMNER OFFERED CITY MANAGER JOB**

Barring any unforeseen developments, the new Athens City Manager will be Seth Sumner. The Athens City Council held a called meeting last Friday and unanimously agreed to offer the position to Sumner. The Council will negotiate a contract with him starting this week. He could start work in February or March. Sumner grew up in Riceville and attended Cleveland State Community College. He is currently the assistant city manager for Savannah, Tennessee.
