♦ COUNCIL APPROVES SUMNER CONTRACT

The Athens City Council has agreed on a contract for Seth Sumner as the new City Manager. The contract calls for a starting salary of \$90,000. Sumner is currently the assistant city manager in Savannah, Tennessee. If he agrees to the contract, he will have to give a two-week notice to the City of Savannah. That means his starting date as the Athens City Manager would probably be February 1st or later.

▶ McMINN SCHOOL BOARD MEMBER DIES

Johnna Hampton, a member of the McMinn County School Board, has died. Ms. Hampton was 51. She died Tuesday at the UT Medical Center where she was being prepared for a lung transplant. (See obituary information on Page Two).

- ◆Effective immediately, James Woolsey is no longer a Senior Advisor to President-Elect Trump or his Transition Team. Woolsey, who served as CIA director under President Bill Clinton, joined President-elect Donald Trump's campaign as a senior adviser in September.
- ◆The Pentagon on Thursday announced four more detainees from Guantanamo Bay will be transferred to Saudi Arabia. This leaves only 55 detainees in the prison. All four detainees were approved or recommended for transfer by multiple departments and agencies that make up the Periodic Review Board. The four individuals are the first of what could be 17 to 19 transfers in the final days of the Obama administration.
