◆ COUNCIL GETS POLICE & FIRE REPORTS

The Athens City Council received the reports on police and fire department activity for the month of April at Tuesday evening's monthly Council meeting. Interim Police Chief Rob Davis reported 62 thefts in April, 20 assaults, seven vehicle thefts, four burglaries, two robberies, and two sex offenses. Officers issued citations for 334 moving violations. There were 80 traffic accidents in April, with 19 injuries. Fire Chief Jim Dyer reported that firefighters responded to 60 calls in April, one was to an industrial fire, 11 were to vehicle accidents, four were grass fires, and there were 17 false alarms. Losses from fires totaled \$76,150. Of the losses, \$25,000 came in a fire at HP Pelzer on April 18th.

- ◆ Amid widespread reports that President Trump gave away highly classified information provided by Israeli intelligence, Trump has declared he had an "absolute right" to share information of a terrorist plot with Russia. The President declined to characterize the information shared as classified and his national security adviser, H.R. McMaster, declined to say as well. Israel quickly declared it had "full confidence" in its intelligencesharing agreement with the US. The intelligence Trump shared involved an Islamic State plot to use bombs hidden in laptop computers to bring down airplanes. White House officials confirmed that it was concerned about a threat to aviation and argued it was appropriate to share such information with Russia, which has also been the victim of terrorism.
- ◆ The founder of a New York City music school for children, Oliver Sohngen, was arrested Tuesday morning on federal charges of alleged sex trafficking of minors. Sohngen allegedly had sex with teen girls and tried to arrange sexual contact with girls as young as 8 years old.
