TVA's rate schedule has three seasons. Summer is June through September and has the highest seasonal base rates. Winter is from December through March. The remaining four months in spring and fall are considered "transition" months and have the lowest base rates.

 \checkmark If you see lots of people doing yard work, painting, or washing vehicles at various agencies today, they are volunteers participating in the United Way's annual Day of Caring.




