◆ Ohio Attorney General, Mike DeWine, has filed a lawsuit against five leading prescription opioid manufacturers, alleging that the companies intentionally misled patients regarding the risks and benefits of opioid use with fraudulent marketing.

WEDNESDAY'S MARKET REPORT: U.S. stocks ticked down today as a slump in bank shares and a mixed reading of economic reports weighed on investor sentiment.

The Dow Jones Industrial Average was down 20.82 at 21,008.65. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was down 1.11 at 2,411.80, and the NASDAQ Composite Index was down 4.67 at 6,198.52.

In Commodity Markets, the spot price of gold rose \$5.65 to \$1,268.80. The spot price of silver fell \$0.07 to \$17.33, and crude oil prices fell \$1.43 to \$48.23.
