National - World News

- ◆ Fired FBI Director James Comey said in prepared testimony that he told President Trump he was not personally under investigation, and that Trump pressured him to say so publicly to lift the "cloud" on his presidency.
- ◆ The disgraced reporter accused of making bomb threats at Jewish Community Centers across the country is set to plead guilty to cyberstalking charges on June 12.
- ◆ Police arrested a male suspect on Wednesday in connection with Saturday's terror attack in London while carrying out a raid on the city's east side. London's Metropolitan Police confirmed that the death toll from the London Bridge terrorist attack has risen to eight people.
- ◆ ISIS claimed responsibility for twin attacks in Iran's capital on Wednesday. One was at the country's parliament building and another at the shrine of Ayatollah Khomeini, the founder of the Islamic Republic of Iran. At least 12 people are dead and several more are injured, according to the BBC.

Plan Now for the Eclipse

Southeast Tennessee is perfectly aligned to experience the total solar eclipse on August 21st. Many cities are making plans to capitalize on the event. The eclipse will arrive in the Athens area at 2:32 p.m. Plans are being made for a Solar Eclipse event at the Athens Regional Park. It will begin at 10 a.m. and last until 3 p.m. There will be food, music, and not quite as much sunshine as usual. Etowah will observe the eclipse with "Hang Out in the Dark" at Starr Mountain Outfitters. Niota will hold a Total Eclipse Festival starting at 12:30 p.m. with music, food, and a speech by Michael Genest, a 37-year veteran of the Johnson Space Center in Houston. The eclipse starts at 2:33 p.m. with a Sun & Moon Festival along the Hiwassee River Blueway in Reliance. There will also be an Adventures Unlimited Eclipse rafting trip down the Ocoee River. In Monroe County, the eclipse begins at 2:32. Eclipse 2017 will be held in Sweetwater from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. with vendors, entertainment, movies, Moon Pies, and moonwalk lessons. Tellico Plains will present "Standing in the Shadow of the Moon," a 3-day celebration hosted by the Charles Hall Museum and the Cherohala Skyway Visitor Center. The total solar eclipse in Southeast Tennessee will last around 2 minutes and 20 seconds depending on the location.
