#### **TOP JOBS FOR SUMNER & PERKINSON**

Athens City Manager C. Seth Sumner (below, left) has been elected president of the Tennessee City Management Association, a statewide group of city management professionals who focus on edu-

cation and training for municipalities. Sumner was elected on June 11th at the board's annual business meeting in Murfreesboro during the annual conference of the Tennessee Municipal League. He will take office on July 1st.

The Tennessee Municipal League has elected Athens City Council member Bo Perkinson as its 2017-2018 president. As president, Perkinson will lead the organization as it determines and proposes legisla-



tion that cities want to see passed into law. He will also play a major role in the National League of Cities, which represents municipalities with Congress and the federal administration.

# **National & World News**

- ◆ U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement is seeking custody of the El Salvador man who is accused of murdering a 17-yearold Muslim girl near a Virginia mosque this weekend. Darwin Martinez Torres, 22, has been detained for the murder of Nabra Hassanen of Reston, Virginia, after he allegedly "became so enraged" that he hit her with a baseball bat. Road rage was the alleged motive behind the murder.
- ◆ An explosion at a train station in Brussels, Belgium, on Tuesday that prompted the station to be evacuated is considered a terrorist attack. There were no victims injured during the explosion.
- ◆ A drop in oil prices pulled U.S. stocks lower on Tuesday. The Dow Jones Industrial Average fell 61.85 to finish at 21,467.14. The Nasdag slid 50.98 to close at 6,188.03, and the S&P 500 finished down 16.43 at 2,437.03.
