#### **◆** ATHENS ANNOUNCES HOLIDAY PLANS

The Athens Municipal Building, Public Works, Recycle Center, and Animal Shelter will be closed next Monday, September 4th, in observance of Labor Day. The residential garbage route for Monday is the only route that will be affected by this holiday closing. Monday's route will be picked up on Tuesday, September 5th.

#### COMMUNITY NEWS YOU CAN USE:

- ✓ Allen Memorial United Methodist Church invites the community to help collect cleaning and hygiene kits for victims of Hurricane Harvey in Texas. Hygiene kits include a hand towel, a washcloth, an adult toothbrush, 6 band aids, 1 bath-size bar of soap, 1 comb, and nail clippers. The items should be delivered in a gallon size bag. Cleaning kits include liquid laundry detergent, liquid household cleaner, dish soap, 1 can of air freshener, 1 insect repellant spray, 1 scrub brush, 18 cleaning wipes, 7 sponges, 50 clothespins, clothesline, 24-roll of heavy-duty trash bags, 5 dust masks, 2 pairs of kitchen dishwashing gloves, 1 pair of work gloves. These should be delivered in a 5-gallon bucket with resealable lid. Take your kits to Allen Memorial Methodist. They may be left under the rear portico or inside the church. # **National & World News**

- ◆ After thousands of Hurricane Harvey evacuees streamed in by the busload to Houston's George R. Brown Convention Center, it is now nearly double its capacity. As of Tuesday morning, there were more than 9,000 people living at the convention center in downtown Houston and thousands more are expected.
- ◆ The catastrophic flooding from Hurricane Harvey is also affecting parts of Louisiana where preparations are underway to evacuate some areas. Residents in the Lake Charles region are once again bracing for impact like they did for Hurricane Katrina 12 years ago.
- Pittsburgh International Airport will be the first major U.S. airport to allow public access to gates since admittance to terminals was restricted in the aftermath of 9/11.



#### **♦ FIGHT LEADS TO INJURIES & CHARGES**

Two Englewood men involved in a fight Tuesday afternoon suffered critical injuries and both could face criminal charges. Sheriff Joe Guy says deputies responded to a fight call on County Road 461 just outside Englewood. They located Michael Holcomb with a stab wound and located the second man, Timothy Martin, some distance away on the roadside with severe injuries to the head and face. Sheriff Guy says the two men got into a fight on the roadside that resulted in one being stabbed and the other beaten. Both men were airlifted to regional hospitals. Sheriff Guy says both men are likely to face charges.
