now. Chief Cliff Couch assumed his new duties in Athens last Monday. Chief Couch is a native of Tallahassee, Florida, and comes to Athens after serving as the police chief in Great Bend, Kansas. He has a Master's Degree in Public Administration from Florida State University. Chief Couch replaces Chuck Ziegler, who retired as police chief at the end of last year. Chief Couch says one of his priorities will be to fill the seven vacant positions on the Athens Police Force, and to create a police department where officers will want to stay. 
