◆ PATE FILES LAWSUIT

Etowah businesswoman Cat Pate has filed a \$1.2 million lawsuit against Etowah City Commissioner Roby Helm. The suit contends that Commissioner Helm made unprofessional, degrading, and harassing comments to her on Facebook. The suit says the comments were made as a result of a dispute with Pate over whether to move the Etowah City Hall out of downtown Etowah to a modular building. Helm has 30 days to respond in writing to the allegations made in the suit.

National - World News

◆ New York City is upping its security ahead of Sunday's marathon race, following the truck ramming attack that killed eight in lower Manhattan on Tuesday afternoon. Over 51,000 runners will be participating and an expected 2.5 million spectators will be lining the streets across multiple boroughs. Police are assuring the public that the marathon will "be a very safe event."

◆ A 19-year-old Syrian man was arrested on Tuesday in Schwerin, Germany. He is suspected of planning an Islamist-motivated attack using "highly explosive" materials according to the German Federal Prosecutor's Office.

WEDNESDAY'S MARKET REPORT: U.S. stocks were higher as investors processed corporate earnings reports and the prospects of a Republican tax-cut proposal expected to be released soon.

The Dow Jones Industrial Average was up 58 points to 23,435. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was up 4 points to 2,579, and the NASDAQ Composite Index was down 11 points to 6,717. In commodity markets, the spot price of gold rose \$4.18 to \$1,275.26, and the price of crude oil fell \$0.10 to \$54.28.
