### ◆ THP SAYS WATCH OUT FOR DEER!

The Tennessee Highway Patrol cautions motorists to watch out

for deer on or near the roadways. An increase in deer-related crashes is likely during November and December due to deer mating and hunting season. Last year, there were 7,219 vehicle-deer collisions in Tennessee, with 330 motorists injured and one fatality. The THP says if you see a



deer cross the road, expect more to follow. You should constantly scan the roadside at dawn and dusk. Do not swerve to avoid hitting a deer since that could cause the vehicle to flop or veer into oncoming traffic.
