The 26 year-old shooter who allegedly killed 26 people and injured at least 20 others in a rural Texas church this weekend had a history of domestic and animal abuse. He was found dead in his car after fleeing the scene of the shooting in Sutherland Springs Sunday morning. Texas law enforcement officials said the shooting was connected to a "domestic situation." He served in the Air Force from 2010 until 2014. He left after receiving a bad conduct discharge, which is the second-lowest level of dismissal in the armed services.
