♦ WIND DAMAGE ON PINE STREET

- ◆ Three inmates, including a homicide suspect, broke out of the Macon County Jail, about 60 miles northeast of Nashville, Tennessee on Wednesday by removing a speaker from the wall. A manhunt is underway for Dylan Cecil Ferguson, Jeffrey Strong and Matt White. Ferguson, 20, who faces charges including criminal homicide for a man's death last year, should be considered armed and dangerous. Subjects may be traveling in a stolen, white, 1990 Ford F-250 with Tennessee tag 3B5-7V2.
- The Air Force Academy confirmed that one of the Air Force cadets targeted by racial slurs on an academy campus was found responsible for writing all the inappropriate messages. An investigation was opened in September into the racial slurs written on the dorm room message boards of five African-American cadet candidates at the Air Force Preparatory School. The individual admitted responsibility and is no longer at the school.


