# State & Local News

#### **◆ ATHENS COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS**

The Athens City Council held its monthly meeting Tuesday night. The Council approved a recommendation to close a portion of College Street from Trinity United Methodist Church to Long Street. This section of College Street runs in front of Sherman Hall, where the school's cafeteria is located. The Council also heard the reports of police and fire department activity for October.

Police Chief Clifton Couch reported there were 55 thefts, 22 assaults, 13 burglaries, 12 motor vehicle thefts, three sex offenses, and one robbery in Athens during October. Chief Couch says officers issued 257 citations for moving violations. There were 93 traffic accidents in October, with 15 injuries. Two of those were pedestrians. There are four vacancies on the police department.

Fire Chief Jim Dyer reported that firefighters responded to 51 calls in October. Losses from fires for the month totaled just \$2,000. Chief Dyer reported the fire department is fully staffed. However, the department is currently 12 short on volunteers. There are 13 volunteer firefighters in the City of Athens.

- ◆ The FBI is investigating the injuries that left one Border Patrol agent dead and another severely injured as a "potential assault." The agents were discovered at the bottom of a ravine in Texas after they responded to foot traffic that set off sensors in the area. The agent that died may have been bludgeoned to death with rocks.
- Robert Mugabe has resigned as the leader of Zimbabwe after more than 30 years in power. The announcement was met with widespread cheers from lawmakers. Mugabe's reported resignation comes amid heightened political tensions in the country.
