♦ ARREST MADE IN MISSING AUTISTIC BOY

In Dickson County, a five-year-old nonverbal autistic boy, Joe Clyde Daniels, was reported missing by his parents on Wednesday, April 4th. After an exhaustive 3-day search, the Tennessee Bureau of Investigation determined that the child's father, Joseph Daniels, intentionally killed his son and hid the child's body. ✓ Two soldiers were killed in a training flight of an Apache attack helicopter at Fort Campbell, Kentucky-Tennessee on Friday. They were killed in a U.S. Army AH-64E Apache helicopter and were assigned to the 101st Airborne Combat Aviation Brigade.

✓ Patrick Reed won the Masters Golf Tournament on Sunday. It was the first time he had ever been to the top in a major golf championship. After shooting in the 60s each of the first three days of the tournament, the 27-year-old only needed a one-under 71 on Sunday to win, finishing at 15-under overall.
