- ◆ The Sheriff of Jasper County, Mississippi has confirmed that the body of the East Ridge, Tennessee double murder suspect, Casey Lawhorn, has been found near the small town of Vossburg, Mississippi. Lawhorn posted on his Facebook page early Sunday that he had killed his mother and her friend. He stated that he was fleeing to a remote rural area to commit suicide.
- ◆ Arizona is deploying 225 National Guard troops to support President Trump's border security mission. The guardsmen will provide mission-enhancing capabilities that will help U.S. Customs and Border Protection increase operational control of the region. The guard will provide air support, reconnaissance support, operational support, construction of border infrastructure and logistical support.
- ◆ Defense Secretary James Mattis is not ruling out possible U.S. airstrikes against Syria in the wake of an apparent chemical weapons attack on a rebel area in Syria where dozens of civilians were killed.
