◆ THREE INJURED IN ATHENS HOUSE FIRE

Three people, including an Athens firefighter, were injured in a house fire at 721 East Madison Avenue Wednesday night. Fire-

men discovered that two people were living in the home and were severely burned. They were an 87year-old woman and her 48-yearold son. A female firefighter ceived head injuries when the ceilcaved while she trying to pull the victims from the house. She will be okay. The two people living in

- ◆ The international monitoring agency on chemical weapons backs the British government's assessment on the poisoning of a former Russian double agent and his daughter by means of a nerve agent. The U.K. investigation by chemical weapons experts along with evidence collected by British security services, found the chemical used in the attack was a type of Soviet-era nerve agent called a Novichok agent.
- ◆ French president Emmanuel Macron stated that French officials have seen proof that the Syrian government carried out a chemical weapons attack last week. They have proof that at least Chlorine gas was used by the Assad regime.

Thursday's Market Report

U.S. stocks rose on positive comments from President Trump on trade and declining concerns about geopolitical tensions. Technology and financials were the best performers. In economic news, initial jobless claims were slightly lower than last week's number but were in line with estimates.

The Dow Jones Industrial Average was up 294 points or 1.2% to 24,483. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was up 22 points or 0.8% to 2,664, and the NASDAQ Composite Index was up 71 points or 1.0% to 7,140.

The spot price of gold fell \$3.07 to \$1,335.04, and the price of crude oil rose \$0.30 to \$67.12.


