#### **♦ McMINN MAN DIES FROM GUNSHOT**

A shooting incident Wednesday resulted in the death of a man in the Nonaburg community on Highway 39 East of Englewood. Sheriff Joe Guy says deputies responded to the call around 11:45 a.m. and found Jacob Leatherman, 22, of Englewood, unresponsive and suffering from a gunshot wound. Deputies and first responders tried CPR without success and Leatherman died from his injuries. Sheriff Guy says it appears the resident, Michael Webb, was shooting a 22 rifle in the yard. At some point, he was stepping back into the residence when the rifle discharged and Leatherman was shot. Sheriff Guy is consulting with the District Attorney's office about the case. Guy says the incident appears to be accidental, but the investigation is continuing.

#### **♦** CONTROLLED BURN IN MONROE CO.

The U.S. Forest Service plans a controlled burn today in the Cherokee National Forest northeast of Coker Creek and southeast of Tellico Plains. The burn involves 1,600 acres. The Forest Service says smoke may be visible in surrounding areas.

- ◆ The U.S. claims to have "credible information and intelligence" that Russian and Syrian regime officials are denying an investigative team access to the alleged chemical weapons attack sites in Douma, Syria, as they sanitize them and remove incriminating evidence.
- ◆ After nearly 60 years of Castro rule, Cuba has a new president. First Vice President Miguel Díaz-Canel was named the next president by The Cuban General Assembly on Wednesday.
- The Dow Jones Industrial Average was down 83 points to close at 24,665. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was down 16 points to 2,693, and the NASDAQ Composite Index was down 57 points to 7,238.
