- ◆ The Texas lieutenant governor Dan Patrick, speaking two days after 10 people were killed at Santa Fe High School in his state. said abortion, divorce and violent video games and movies show that "we have devalued life," which he pointed to as a cause of school shootings across the country. Patrick appeared on ABC's "This Week."
- ◆ Fred Guttenberg, whose 14-year-old daughter, Jaime, was among the 17 people killed in a school massacre earlier this year in Parkland, Florida, followed Patrick on ABC's "This Week." Guttenberg, who has become a gun control activist since his daughter's murder, slammed Patrick's remarks as the "most idiotic comments I've heard regarding gun safety."


Obituaries
