◆ LOCAL POWER RATES TO REMAIN FLAT

Electric power rates in the Athens area for July will be virtually unchanged compared to current June rates, as the TVA monthly fuel rate per month is nearly the same. AUB spokesman Wayne Scarbrough says your utility bill is comprised of two components, the base rate and the fuel charge. He says the sum of those is known as your "all-up rate," and that determines what you pay based on your electricity usage.

- ◆ Koko, the western lowland gorilla who learned sign language and became a pop-culture phenomenon, has died at the age of 46, in Woodside, California.
- Some thrill-seekers are getting too close for comfort taking selfies near the Kilauea volcano eruption on the Big Island in Hawaii and posting them on social media. Some are standing mere feet away from rivers of lava. Authorities are cracking down, and at least a dozen people have been cited or arrested in the last 10 days. More than 500 homes have been destroyed or damaged from the hot lava, and the Kilauea volcano lava flow shows no signs of abating.
