The Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency has finalized the details for the 2018 sand hill crane hunting season permit allotment. The number of sand hill harvest tags will increase to 2,711, up from 2,300 tags allotted last hunting season. There will be a hand-held drawing for the permits on Saturday, August 11th, at 10 a.m. at Rhea County High School in Evansville.
