◆ **REWARD OFFERED FOR ESCAPEES**
 The Bradley County Sheriff's Office and the Cleveland Police Department are offering a combined reward of \$1000 for information leading to the capture of Abraham Julien Augustin, age 16, and Memphis Aahmod Smith, age 16, pictured on the right. National News

◆ Hania Noleia Aguilar, 13-year-old eighth-grader from Lumberton, North Carolina was kidnapped in front of her home just before 7 a.m. Hania was waiting to go to school when a witness saw a man dressed in all black with a yellow bandanna approach the teen and force her into a stolen car. The car is a green 2002 Ford Expedition with South Carolina license plate number NWS984. The suspect drove away with Hania. Anyone with information is asked to call the Lumberton Police Department at 910-671-3845.

◆ On Monday, the United States fully reimposed sanctions on Iran that were lifted under the nuclear deal, and added more than 300 new Iranian individuals, entities and vessels to the sanctions list.

◆ On Friday, Gunmen attacked two buses and a microbus on a road near the Monastery of Saint Samuel the Confessor, in Minya, south of Cairo killing at least seven people and injuring at least 19 others. The passengers had travelled to the monastery for the baptism of one of its children, six of whom were injured.

TBI Seeks ID Help

At the request of District Attorney General Steve Crump, the Tennessee Bureau of Investigation has joined the Polk County Sheriff's Office in investigating the discovery of partially skeletonized remains found on Benton Mountain, about four miles west of State Hwy 30, south of Reliance. The body is that of a male, but the race and height are unknown. Multiple tattoos were observed on the man's legs. A sketch of them and the location on the body are to the right. Law enforcement officials are hoping someone may recognize the tattoos and be able to identify the man whose body was found last week.
