#### **National & World News**

- ◆ More than 40 people have died in the wildfires spreading through California. Over a dozen states have sent crews to help with the fires as thousands of firefighters continue to fight the deadly blazes.
- ◆ Approximately 100 of an estimated 11,000 migrants, may reach the U.S. border south of San Diego on Sunday. That's less than 1 percent of those U.S. officials are tracking across four groups. The overwhelming majority of those from Central America, that are fleeing hardship on foot, are hundreds of miles away and several weeks from nearing U.S. soil.


