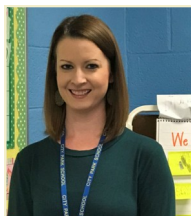

National & World News

◆ Defense Secretary James Mattis defends the deployment of thousands of active duty troops to the border with Mexico. Mattis said it's "a moral and ethical mission to support our border patrolmen." While visiting with some of the soldiers deployed to the southern U.S. border, Mattis said that border security is part of our national security. He also stressed that the military mission is strictly to support U.S. Customs and Border Protection as it prepares for the arrival of four migrant caravans in the coming weeks.

◆ Cities along the East Coast are bracing for the first snowfall of the season as a storm developing in the Gulf Coast will strengthen and bring heavy rain to Georgia, Tennessee, and the Carolinas. Snow, rain and freezing rain is possible in the southern Appalachian Mountains and the Ohio Valley, and by Thursday afternoon, snow is expected across the mid-Atlantic from Washington, D.C., to New York City.

WEDNESDAY'S MARKET REPORT: U.S. stocks finished lower, led by declines in financials and technology sectors. The Labor Department said that the consumer price index, a measurement for inflation, rose 0.3% in October from the prior month.

The Dow Jones Industrial Average was down 206 points or 0.8% to 25,081. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was down 21 points or 0.8% to 2,702, and the NASDAQ Composite Index was down 64 points or 0.9% to 7,136.
