1703 - John Wesley, the founder of Methodism, was born in England. He was one of 19 children. In the 1730's he traveled to the American colony of Georgia where he attempted to convert the Indians.

THURSDAY'S MARKET REPORT: U.S. stocks finished the day mixed. Ten out of eleven sectors in the S&P were up with financial stocks leading the way. In economic news, initial jobless claims came in higher than expected last week. A separate report showed GDP first quarter was unchanged from the previous quarter. U.S. Treasury prices increased. Interest rates declined. The Dow Jones Industrial Average was down 10 points to 26,526. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was up 11 points or 0.4% to 2,925, and the NASDAQ Composite Index was up 58 points or 0.7% to 7,965.
