◆ TIME TO START RAKING THOSE LEAVES

Loose Leaf collection in the City of Athens will get underway on Monday, November 4th, at 7 a.m. If you would like your leaves to be collected, rake them three to five feet from the edge of the road as soon as they fall to the ground. **Do Not place leaves in the road, in drainage ditches, or on sidewalks.** In areas where there are sidewalks, leaves should be placed behind the sidewalk. Do not place leaves on or around obstacles such as mailboxes, trees, fences, poles, yard decorations, and vehicles. Leaf crews will work in specified zones throughout the city. Once they complete a zone, they will move on to the next zone. Once crews complete all zones one time, they will start back at the first zone and go through all zones a second time.


