

Judge Refuses to Dismiss Wielzen Charges

Judge Sandra Donaghy has denied the motion to dismiss the charges against Joseph Wielzen on the grounds he has been denied a speedy trial. Wielzen is accused of raping and killing Kelsey Burnette in Etowah in 2017. Police say she was murdered on the night of June 30th or the early morning of July 1st, 2017. Her body was found on July 4th. Wielzen was arrested a year later in connection with her murder. Judge Donaghy ruled the delay in his trial was necessary for fair prosecution. She said she does not believe Wielzen faces the level of anxiety that amounts to prejudice in court. The judge mentioned that Wielzen testified he did not know what anxiety was when asked by his attorney. The court is now moving on to a defense motion for a change of venue so Wielzen can have a fair trial. There are 33 more motions to be ruled on prior to the trial. Judge Donaghy says the trial is set to begin on November 13th.
